Through self-documentation, self-censorship and surveillance, Watching You identifies issues of security, fetishized observation, and the psychological implications of watching/being watched. The artists retain distance from the individual subject, reflecting the mechanical and digital sensibilities of image-making and perception.

Watching You addresses themes of desire and control over oneself and others. Between selfies and CCTV, smartphones and Google, we are gridlocked in algorithmic visualizations of data. We instigate power, desire, and pleasure, drawing out a trajectory for the impact of technologies upon consciousness.

From December 11-22, you are invited to engage and reflect on suspect acts of observation inside a space that is itself lived in.
